- 2. Describe an experience where someone or something had an impact on your life and how it changed you.

Eligibility

Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a member in good-standing with Greylock Federal Credit Union prior to applying
- Demonstrate an outstanding level of community and volunteer work
- Must be a college-bound senior attending a public high school in Berkshire County at the time of application

Application

To apply, members must fill out the Scholarship Application Form. The application must be returned no later than Friday **April 17, 2020**. Each school will be notified of the chosen scholarship recipients by **May 8, 2020**.
